



Social Skills Program

Groups run continuously throughout the year. Children register for 6 sessions at a time, which we've found is the minimum needed to help kids build comfort, connection, and social confidence. Please note that age ranges are provided as a guide to help parents; however, the providers will make recommendations for placement in the groups according to what is the best fit for the children participating.

Social Skills Options

***Preschool/Kindergarten Social Play Club** (Ages 4–6)– Tuesdays, 4:00–5:00 PM
Supports foundational play, emotional regulation, and readiness for group learning.

***Social Play Club** (Ages 6–9)– Wednesdays, 4:00–5:00 PM
Focuses on friendship skills, flexibility during play, and managing emotions.

***Social Skills Group** (Ages 10–13) – Tuesdays, 4:30–5:30 PM
Helps participants strengthen communication, navigate peer relationships, and build social confidence.

 - Preschool & Play Clubs: \$100/session (billed as \$600 for 6 sessions at first session)
